 - b. Submit a **Cover Letter** addressed to the "Fellows Program Selection Committee" specifying your background, qualifications, and interest in this program
 - c. Submit a 1-2 page, double-spaced, essay describing your **experience and interest in the field** and your **motivation** for completing a summer internship with an entrepreneurial company
